#### **TERM DEFINITIONS**

**World Rugby** – Worldwide association of Rugby Unions or Associations

**Rugby Europe** – European association of Rugby Unions

**World Rugby and Rugby Europe Rules and Regulations** – Acts set and approved by World Rugby and Rugby Europe

**Laws of the Game** – Laws of the Game of Rugby Union set by World Rugby

**Participating team** – Rugby team taking part in the Women Regional Rugby Sevens as listed in Addition 1 of these Regulations

**Participating Union** – National rugby union of Participating team

**WRRS - Women Regional Rugby Sevens** – The competition to which these propositions relate.

#### **1. GENERAL REGULATIONS**

- 1.1 U regional competition Women Regional Rugby Sevens (hereinafter WRRS) participate rugby teams listed in Addition 1 of these Regulations. WRRS Board by absolute majority of votes of all Participating teams does changes and amendments of Addition 1 of these Regulations after the ending of each WRRS season, at least one (1) month before the scheduled date of the first match of next WRRS season.
- 1.2 The winner of the WRRS season gains a right to a title of the Winner of WRRS for the ending year of the WRRS season and the right of further competition if organized by Rugby Europe.
- 1.3 WRRS matches of are played under all World Rugby Laws and Regulations with specific amendments/variations made where necessary.
- 1.4 The WRRS is competition that is independent of national championships carried out by Participating Unions.
- 1.5 By signing and submitting proper form letter as presented in Addition 3 of these Regulations to the WRRS Competition Commissioner, each Participating Union accepts WRRS competition as a regular part of playing season, agrees to adopt National Championships to the WRRS schedule and agrees to confirm decisions by WRRS Board about penalties for players in their own competitions. Participating Union must sign and submit this form letter at least seven (7) days before the scheduled date of the first match of the WRRS season.

#### **2. COMPETITION MANAGEMENT**

- 2.1 WRRS Board manages WRRS competition. Each Participating team can have one representative in WRRS Board.
- 2.2 Participating team assign direct competition management to WRRS Competition Commissioner. WRRS Competition Commissioner is one of the WRRS Board members.
- 2.3 Representatives of Participating teams elect among them WRRS Board members and WRRS Competition Commissioner at joint meeting of representatives of Participating teams by absolute majority of votes of all Participating teams.

- 2.4 WRRS Competition Commissioner is in charge of the administrative matters of the WRRS Board and is obliged to distribute WRRS Board decisions in writing.
- 2.5 The mode of the WRRS Board functioning is agreed upon by all of its members (via telephone conference, correspondence and/or meetings). WRRS Board shall take decisions by absolute majority of votes of all members.
- 2.6 Before each WRRS tournament, at least seven (7) days before the tournament, WRRS Competition Commissioner delivers to Participating teams, and other parties concerned, the written notice (or e-mail). By that notice, WRRS Competition Commissioner informs them on the date, kick-off time and venue of the tournament, the Tournament Commissioner and Referees assigned for the tournament.
- 2.7 WRRS Competition Commissioner, after each WRRS tournament, issues a report on the progress of the competition, and delivers it to the Participating teams, to other members of the WRRS Board, executive bodies of Participating Unions and referee organizations of Participating Unions.
- 2.8 In this report, WRRS Competition Commissioner deals with any other question while adhering to these Regulations, Laws of the Game and World Rugby and Rugby Europe Rules and Regulations.
- 2.9 Participating team can submit a complaint regarding the decisions and the reports of the Competition Commissioner to the WRRS Board.

### 3. METHOD OF COMPETITION

- 3.1 WRRS matches are women rugby 7 matches according to the current Laws of the Game of Rugby Union.
- 3.2 WRRS competition is a tournament system in which each Participating team can organize at most one tournament.
- 3.3 Each WRRS tournament can include other teams than Participating teams. Match schedule on each WRRS tournament must enable unambiguous final tournament classification of Participating teams that were participating on that tournament.
- 3.4 Each Participating team has an obligation to show on every WRRS tournament. In case of no show, WRRS Board shall decide on justification of absence and possible sanctions.
- 3.5 WRRS tournaments are played in the following periods: from September 8<sup>th</sup> to November 10<sup>th</sup> and from April 7<sup>th</sup> to two weeks prior to first Rugby Europe Women 7s European Championship tournament with at least one of Participating Unions taking part.

### 4. POINTS SYSTEM

- 4.1 Each Participating team during WRRS season gains Tournament points according to tournament classification. Participating team with more Tournament points gained takes a better place.
- 4.2 In the event of two or more teams with the same number of Tournament points, the teams will be classified according to the following:
  - Results of mutual matches during WRRS season
    - More Match points gained in mutual matches
    - Better total points differential in mutual matches
    - More total number of tries scored in mutual matches
  - Total points differential in matches played with all Participating teams during WRRS season
  - Total number of tries scored in matches played with all Participating teams during WRRS season

- Less sent-off players in matches played with all Participating teams during WRRS season
- Less yellow card bins in matches played with all Participating teams during WRRS season.

4.3 The following Tournament points system will be used in WRRS competition:

- Best classified Participating team on WRRS tournament gets 10 Tournament points
- Second best classified Participating team on WRRS tournament gets 8 Tournament points
- Third best classified Participating team on WRRS tournament gets 6 Tournament points
- Fourth best classified Participating team on WRRS tournament gets 4 Tournament points
- Fifth best classified Participating team on WRRS tournament gets 3 Tournament points
- Sixth best classified Participating team on WRRS tournament gets 2 Tournament points
- Seventh best classified Participating team on WRRS tournament gets 1 Tournament point
- Participating teams that didn't show on WRRS tournament get no Tournament points

4.4 The following Match points system will be used in WRRS competition matches:

- Three (3) Match points for the win, two (2) Match points for a draw and one (1) Match point for the loss.
- For the match that is lost due to the organizational oversight, the team is awarded no (0) Match points.
- A team that forfeits a match will receive minus three (-3) Match points.

4.5 In the event of two or more teams with the same number of Match points in a group stage of WRRS tournament, the order of teams will be solved in the way explained in article 4.2 of these Regulations.

4.6 WRRS Board will solve by its decision any withdrawal from the WRRS competition of a Participating team, as well as any consequences of such a case in terms of scoring and classification.

## 5. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

5.1 Players aged eighteen (18) years or older are eligible to play for Participating team in WRRS matches. Each player must have a valid registration with the home Rugby Union.

5.2 Players younger than eighteen (18) are eligible to play for Participating team if Participating team delivers to WRRS Competition Commissioner both:

- Parental consent form – Parent/guardian approval statement taking over responsibility for attending a juvenile on seniors matches (form “Parental consent form” in section Competition forms of this Regulations) signed by parent/guardian.
- Team manager liability form –The statement of the team manager of Participating team on taking over the responsibility and that the specified player can play for the senior team in terms of physical and mental ability (form “Team manager liability form” in section Competition forms of this Regulations) signed by team manager of Participating team.

5.3 If Participating team is a member of Participating Union that requires appropriate medical exams and certificates for player to play a rugby match are required to deliver such player's certificates for WRRS matches.

## 6. EQUIPMENT

- 6.1 Players of Participating teams compete in jerseys marked with numbers. A team must not have two players wearing a jersey with the same number. The Tournament Commissioner must approve all substitutions and replacements.
- 6.2 Each Participating team must inform the WRRS Competition Commissioner of the colour of their jerseys for following season by written notice or by e-mail at least seven (7) days before the scheduled date of the first match of the WRRS season.
- 6.3 The WRRS Competition Commissioner will inform all the Participating teams of the jersey colours for following season of all Participating teams by written notice or by e-mail at least five (5) days before the scheduled date of the first match of the WRRS season.
- 6.4 The following rules apply to the choice of the colour of the jerseys:
  - If both teams applied for the same colour jerseys, the home team should change the jersey colour. If the home team refuses to change the jersey colour, the home team loses the game due to the organizational oversight.
  - If the guest team wishes to compete in jerseys that are the same colour as the home team jerseys, and that is not the applied jersey colour of the guest team and the home team insists on their jersey colour, the guest team should change the colour of their jerseys. If the guest team does not have another kit, it must agree to play in home team spare kit. If the guest team refuses to play in home teams spare kit, the guest team loses the game due to the organizational oversight.
- 6.5 If Participating team omits to inform WRRS Competition Commissioner of the colour of their jerseys by written notice or by e-mail at least seven (7) days before the scheduled date of the first match of the WRRS season the colour of their jerseys will be considered as "void". Participating team with "void" colour of their jerseys is losing any advantage of choosing colour of the jerseys except when two Participating teams with "void" colour of the jerseys play among themselves, then guest team has the advantage of choosing colour of the jerseys.

## 7. TOURNAMENT REPORT

- 7.1 The Tournament report form is the same for all Participating teams and for all WRRS matches. WRRS Competition Commissioner will deliver the Tournament report form to each Participating team by the at least five (5) days before the scheduled date of the first match of the WRRS season.
- 7.2 During a match, Tournament report form is filled by Tournament Commissioner or the person authorized by Tournament Commissioner.
- 7.3 Tournament Commissioner must send Tournament Report to the WRRS Competition Commissioner by e-mail or fax. WRRS Competition Commissioner distributes this report to the Referees, Participating teams and Participating Unions.

## 8. TOURNAMENT COMMISSIONER

- 8.1 Each WRRS tournament organizer must appoint Tournament Commissioner and must send notice about that to WRRS Competition Commissioner at least three (3) weeks before the scheduled date of the tournament.
- 8.2 If due to force majeure the Tournament Commissioner is unable to perform his duty, WRRS tournament organizer will appoint substitute Tournament Commissioner to replace him/her. WRRS tournament organizer must send notice about that to WRRS Competition Commissioner as soon as possible.
- 8.3 Tournament Commissioner will perform his duty according to these Regulations, Laws of the Game, as well as World Rugby and Rugby Europe Rules and Regulations.

- 8.4 If the assigned Tournament Commissioner is not present at a match, one of Referees of the tournament will carry out his duties. In this case, the WRRS Competition Commissioner, who must make his arbitration within seven (7) days, will carry out the disciplinary arbitration.

## 9. REFEREES

- 9.1 Each Participating Union, or referee organization of each Participating Union, upon request from WRRS Competition Commissioner, must delegate Referees for particular WRRS tournament – “List of referees”.
- 9.2 WRRS Competition Commissioner must send request for “List of referees” to Participating Union at least three (3) days before the scheduled date of WRRS tournament.
- 9.3 WRRS Competition Commissioner, together with Participating team that is tournament organizer, delegates at least two Referees for each WRRS tournament from “Lists of referees” provided by Participating Unions.
- 9.4 Participating team that is tournament organizer must ensure participation of at least two Referees and sufficient number of Assistant referees on the WRRS tournament.
- 9.5 In case of referee or his substitution being unable to referee a match, tournament organizer will respect referee regulations of the Participating Union covering the venue.
- 9.6 If WRRS Board finds the referees nominated by Participating Union referee organizations insufficient in skill or numbers, at a request of a Participating Union, referees from unions not part of WRRS and licensed by their home unions may be nominated for WRRS tournament

## 10. APPEAL TO A MATCH PLAYED

- 10.1 Participating team can submit an appeal to a played match to the Tournament Commissioner in written form immediately after the match or by e-mail to WRRS Competition Commissioner, no later than twenty-four (24) hours from the end of the tournament.
- 10.2 Tournament Commissioner will rule on the appeal submitted to him/her together with Referees as soon as possible, but before next match of any of Participating teams involved in appeal.
- 10.3 Participating team involved can submit the appeal on the ruling of the Tournament Commissioner to the WRRS Competition Commissioner by e-mail no later than twenty-four (24) hours from the end of the tournament.
- 10.4 WRRS Competition Commissioner will rule on the appeal and inform the WRRS Board and all Participating teams involved within the five (5) days of the delivery of all pertinent documents.
- 10.5 Participating team involved can submit the appeal on the ruling of the WRRS Competition Commissioner to the RRC Board within the five (5) days of notification about upper mentioned WRRS Competition Commissioner ruling.
- 10.6 The WRRS Board will rule on this appeal within the reasonable time, no longer than fifteen (15) days. The WRRS Board ruling cannot be subject to appeal.

## 11. DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE

- 11.1 If a Referee sends-off a player during WRRS tournament, that player cannot play rugby union matches until the end of that tournament day. Immediately after last match of that tournament day player must go attend the hearing and disciplinary ruling.
- 11.2 Tournament Commissioner will conduct procedure of the hearing and disciplinary ruling using statements from Referee, sent-off player, both team managers and other persons if needed. Tournament Commissioner must produce written report and disciplinary ruling according to World Rugby Sanctions for Foul Play (Regulation 17).

- 11.3 Sanctioned player cannot participate in any rugby union match during ruled time of sanction.
- 11.4 Tournament Commissioner must send all documentation regarding disciplinary procedure to WRRS Competition Commissioner.
- 11.5 WRRS Competition Commissioner shall, by his/her decision, notify and publish all rulings and determine end dates of sanctions.
- 11.6 Tournament Commissioners rulings and Competition Commissioners decision may be subject to an appeal by any involved party. The appellant must submit appeal in written form to the WRRS Board within three (3) days of pertinent ruling or decision and the WRRS Board will rule on this appeal within fourteen (14) days. The WRRS Board ruling cannot be subject to appeal.
- 11.7 If a team leaves the playing area during WRRS match and refuses to continue the match, pertinent Participating team will be penalized by expulsion from current WRRS season and all other competitions organized by or related to WRRS for the period of one (1) year.

## 12. MEDICAL REGULATIONS

- 12.1 A medical doctor must be present at every WRRS match. No WRRS match will begin without the presence of a medical doctor and a clear approach for medical emergency vehicle.
- 12.2 During a WRRS match, home team must provide the use of medical emergency vehicle if necessary.
- 12.3 All costs of the medical services, domestic or abroad, due to injuries of Participating team player or the Participating team official during or related to WRRS tournament matches will be borne by the his/her Participating team or will be covered by their insurance, should they have it. All costs, domestic or abroad, regarding the accident of the Participating team player or the Participating team official during or related to WRRS tournament matches will be borne by his/her Participating team or will be covered by their insurance, should they have it.
- 12.4 Tournament Commissioner must enter all serious injuries and particularly those that require hospital treatment in the Tournament report. WRRS Competition Commissioner keeps record of such injuries and delivers a report thereof to the Medical committee of Rugby Europe.
- 12.5 If the appropriate anti-doping agency responsible for the location of the WRRS tournament decides to implement anti-doping control, and if they perform such control according to the anti-doping regulations of International Olympic Committee (IOC) that are identical to the World Rugby and Rugby Europe anti-doping regulations, all summoned players must immediately allow the control to take place. Athlete non-responding to anti-doping control, whether in or outside the competition, is treated as if its finding is positive and is automatically suspended with a minimum suspension of two (2) years.
- 12.6 In case of anti-doping control, the Tournament Commissioner will make a note in the Tournament report, while WRRS Competition Commissioner notifies Rugby Europe thereof.

## 13. FINANCIAL REGULATIONS

- 13.1 Away team covers its expenses (travel and stay).
- 13.2 Participating team that is tournament organizer covers all match organization expenses which include the following:
  - The venue in accordance with Laws of the Game
  - A sufficient amount of drinking water for all participants of the WRRS tournament
  - Official medical doctor
  - Use of medical emergency vehicle

- Notification to the local police and authorities
- 13.3 Participating team that is tournament organizer must pay to each Referee fee of 30.00 € net amount (all eventual taxes and other similar fees are responsibility of organizer) payable in local currency.
- 13.4 Participating team that is tournament organizer must pay fees to Referees at least one (1) hour prior to kick-off of the first match of the tournament.
- 13.5 The WRRS Board with written approval of all WRRS participants will determine all other payments or changes of fees and allowances.

#### 14. FINAL REGULATIONS

- 14.1 Due to different currencies in the participants' countries, all expenses are stated in Euros.
- 14.2 Match schedule for WRRS season composed by WRRS Competition Commissioner, as defined in Addition 2 is a part of these Regulations.
- 14.3 Should any company find it in its interest to add its name to the WRRS or to use WRRS for its marketing purposes, it can only be realized upon terms and conditions defined and agreed at the meeting of WRRS Board.
- 14.4 These Regulations are valid until the cancelation by WRRS Board. WRRS Board can do cancelation of these Regulations with absolute majority of all votes.
- 14.5 Changes and amendments of these Regulations, except for those defined by these Regulations, are done in the same way the Regulations are approved, by agreement of all participants in WRRS.
- 14.6 The WRRS Board provides ruling regarding these Regulations.
